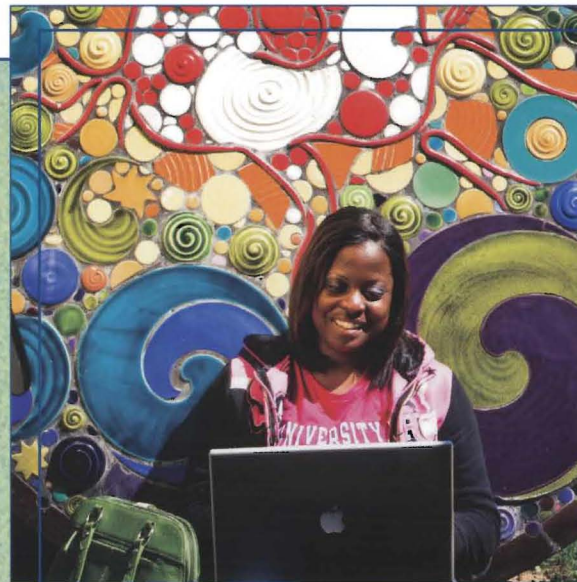

1. **Research:** We conduct interdisciplinary theory- and problem-based research aimed at improving human performance and quality of life.

3. **Training and Education:** To serve the needs of the local community, CAP, in collaboration with other departments at the university, offers workshops, seminars, continuing education credit and professional development courses.

4. **Development of Future Scholars and Leaders:**

CAP is committed to the growth of students into future scholars and leaders through experiential learning. Under the guidance of faculty and research professionals affiliated with the center, students practice the professional skills they need to become contributing members of their professions and communities. We encourage professional development through active participation in research, internship and service learning opportunities, and center-sponsored lectures and workshops.

- ❖ Conduct surveys, program evaluations and statistical analyses.
- ❖ Conduct organizational needs assessments, job analyses and organizational interventions.
- ❖ Develop and validate selection and appraisal systems and training programs.
- ❖ Deliver programs for leadership development, team building, diversity training and professional ethics.
- ❖ Deliver professional development workshops on topics such as marriage and family therapy.
- ❖ Develop programs of health and safety such as HIV/AIDS prevention and treatment of headaches as well as workshops for meditation, self-control and stress reduction.
- ❖ Provide crisis and disaster debriefings.
- ❖ Develop programs for high-risk children and adolescents; foster activities to improve quality of life for aging populations.

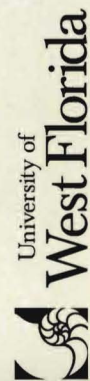

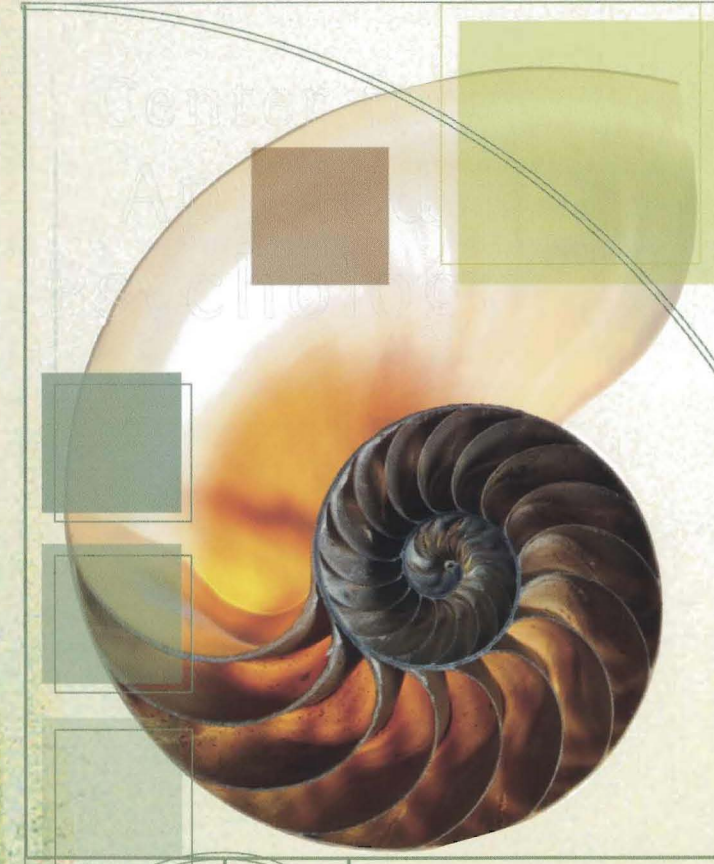
