WHERE WAS PATTON? OZ NUNN

D-Day! 6 June 1944! The last great crusade! The Allied invasion of Festung Europa-Fortress Europe, as Adolf Hitler called it. Everyone knew it was coming- everyone, including the Nazis. The two big questions were: (1) When? (2) Where? All of the top American, British and Allied officers were involved in the planning and preparation for the invasion – Eisenhower, Marshall, Bradley & Montgomery. But, **WHERE WAS PATTON?** Where was General George S. Patton? He was in England, but he did not hit the beaches or lead the charge on D-Day. In fact, he did not arrive in France until several weeks after D-Day. He was our best tactical officer – a ferocious combat leader, but he was not part of the invasion, physically. **WHERE WAS PATTON?** General Patton did not hit the beaches on D-Day, but he was definitely involved in the invasion. Actually, the role he played in Operation Overload, the code name for the invasion, probably enabled the operation to be a success. Please join us as Oz Nunn tells us exactly the role Patton played in the invasion. Even though Patton did not participate physically in the invasion, without him, the results of D-Day could have been far different. Many people are unaware of this. **WHERE WAS PATTON?**
