HARPER LEES'S "TO KILL A MOCKINGBIRD"

Description: Join us in a bus trip to Monroeville, Alabama, to see the two-act play adaptation of Harper Lee's novel *To Kill a Mockingbird* performed at the Old Courthouse Museum. Monroeville is best known as the home of Pulitzer Prize-winning author Harper Lee and her childhood friend, Truman Capote. A Good Times Tour bus (with restroom and television) will depart at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 29, 2010, from Food World located on the northeast corner of Davis Highway & Olive Road. The ride to Monroeville takes about two hours. We will have time to tour some of the historic exhibits in Monroeville and have dinner at Radley's Fountain Grille before the two hour play begins at 7:00 p.m. The bus will return to Food World at about 11:00 p.m. The \$70.00 cost includes a ticket to the play plus transportation. **We must have 40 paid confirmed and nonrefundable seats to cover all the costs by January 4,**

2010.
