

CALL FOR PAPERS: SPRING 2007

We are happy to announce that manuscripts are now being accepted for publication in the first issue of *ArgoJournals*, an electronic journal published by the Psychology Department at the University of West Florida. We encourage all undergraduate students wishing to share their work with the greater academic community to submit a manuscript for consideration. Please review the following guidelines and directions before submitting your document.

What kinds of papers are accepted?

One of our primary goals in publishing this Journal is to foster an academic culture that recognizes the value of sharing and exchanging ideas and information. Thus, we do not wish to place many limitations on our authors, and we look forward to reviewing manuscripts of various kinds covering myriad topics. We accept empirical research as well as literature reviews, historical articles, and other scholarly works. Topics may be related to counseling, developmental, experimental, human factors, industrial/organizational, personality, quantitative psychology, as well as other issues of relevance to behavioral science.

Who can submit?

- We only accept manuscripts authored by undergraduate students. When appropriate, professors and graduate students may be listed as co-authors. Contributions from graduate students will be accepted if the work was completed at a time when the primary author was an undergraduate student.
- Although work submitted by students attending the University of West Florida will be given preference, we encourage all interested undergraduate students to contribute.

How should I prepare my document?

- All manuscripts must be prepared according to the *Publications Manual of the American Psychological Association*, 5th edition.
- On the cover page please include the author's name and contact information; no other identifying information should appear in the body of the paper.
- Papers should be no longer than 20 pages double-spaced, approximately 5,000 words. Include an abstract of less than 150 words in the first page of the submission.
- Embed figures and illustrations in the text as jpegs and type tables directly into the document.
- An image related to the thesis or area of research is required, and will be posted online adjacent to the abstract. Save the image as a jpeg, and have it ready before going online to submit the work electronically.

How do I submit my work?

- Before submission, please ensure that your work has been approved by an Institutional Review Board. In addition to submitting the work online, send a separate letter to the Associate Editor stating the nature of your submission and verification of approval by the IRB.
- We do not require a hard-copy. Instead, save your work as a Word file and submit it electronically at <http://www.uwf.edu/argojournal/submit/>
