“What Happens If I Don’t remember my JasonQuest username and password?” and other JasonQuest tips...

If you are receiving this e-minder, guess what--you DO have a JasonQuest account! But in this day and age with so many usernames and passwords floating around, you may not remember how to log in.

“I don’t remember my JasonQuest username.”

In this instance, please do not create a new account for yourself. Please stop by Career Services, Building 19, call 474-2254 or e-mail career@uwf.edu to request your username. We will ask for some identifying information before we release it to you. Now, skip to question 2.

“I remember my JasonQuest username, but not my password.”

In this instance, please do not create a new account for yourself. Unfortunately because your password is protected, we will not be able to view it either. After you put your username into the student login page in JasonQuest you can simply click the “forgot your password” link and the system will e-mail it to you. If you don’t remember which e-mail you used when you set up the account, we will be glad to supply you with that information. Please stop by Career Services, Building 19, call 474-2254 or e-mail career@uwf.edu to request your username. We will ask for some identifying information before we release it to you.

Career Services staff members recommend updating your JasonQuest account every time there is a change to your demographic or academic status. ***If nothing else, at least once a semester.*** Remember, JasonQuest can be used to search for part-time employment, full-time employment, internships, cooperative education, volunteer opportunities, employer information for networking purposes, career events, and on-campus interviewing.
