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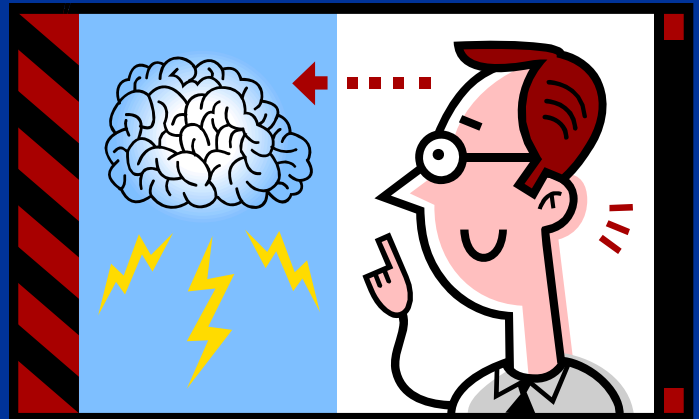
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Career Exploration Teams: A Go!

A brand new program has hit the highway at Career Services, and it's about to be underway. February 6th will start the first of three, four-week long sessions that are aimed at providing students who are classified as "Undecided", unsure about choosing a major, or unsure about what sort of occupational field to venture into. Each group, which will consist of no more than 5 students, will meet for 90 minutes a week, each of the four weeks. Students will partake in personality inventories, interest assessments, and other activities to explore individual wants and needs in regard to a fulfilling field of study. Students will learn how to connect their values to their desired field of study and explore goalsetting.

The starting dates for the three sessions are February 6th @ 10am, February 12th @ 2pm, and the March 26th session has a TBA time. These sessions are being coordinated by Lauren Loeffler, Assistant Director of Career Services, and Eric Middleton, a Graduate Assistant for Career Services.
