Two, don't feel as if you have to hand out every single one of them. Many companies are now starting to handle their hiring services online and may ask you to submit your resume on your computer.

- **What's Your Name?** Always get the recruiter's name. It'll help you direct your emails and phone calls post-Expo when corresponding with the company of interest.

- **Network With Others!** Don't look at other job-seekers as competition. It takes the fun out of looking for the perfect job, and starts to create negativity in an environment where positivity MUST be completely and thoroughly present.
