- Don't make negative remarks about the company, even in jest.
- Don't make excuses about your behavior or actions. It gives the impression that you are unconfident about yourself, or that you are dishonest about your actions.
- Whatever you do, don't lie on the application or answers to interview questions. If you get caught in the act; it will destroy your chances of being employed with the company.
- Don't give the impression that you are only interested in the position's salary. Don't ask about the salary or benefits until the interviewer brings the subject up.
- Don't chew gum. Don't smell of smoke.
- Leave your phone in the car. Don't even bring it in the building, you will fidget with it and be preoccupied with it.
- Don't go to extremes with your posture. Don't sit on the edge of the chair, and don't slouch either.
- Don't be unprepared for typical interview questions; you may not be asked all of them, but being unprepared looks foolish.
