## ART GALLERY HOURS:

The Art Gallery hosts several afternoon and evening events during the year, and also remains open one hour prior to all CFPA events. Regular gallery hours are 10 am to 5 pm Tuesday through Friday. The Art Gallery is free and open to the public. When visiting the Art Gallery between 10 am and 4:30 pm, please stop by the University's Visitors Center to receive a free Guest Pass.

## PARKING:

- All parking on the UWF campus is free after 4:30 pm Monday through Friday and on the weekends.
- When visiting the Art Gallery between 10 am and 4:30 pm, please stop by the University's Visitors Center to receive a free Guest Pass.
- There is a drop-off location directly in front of the CFPA that can be used for ticket purchases during the day and drop off and pick up of passengers before and after the performance. Parking in the drop-off location is not permitted.
- There are two parking lots that are easily accessible for the CFPA, Lot L & Lot M.

## SEATING:

- At the present time all performances have an open seating policy (no reserved seats). The house opens one half hour prior to curtain and patrons are advised to arrive early for the best selection.
- Late Seating is at the discretion of the management and will vary according to the performance. To ensure the safety of those being seated and as a courtesy to the audience and the performers, this may require a delay until an appropriate time in the performance.

## FREE EVENTS:
