



## The Problem: Finding Time

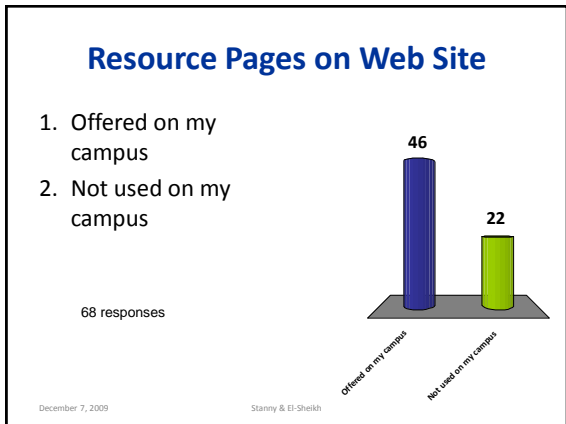
