### **Internship Description-**

We will be seeking applicants for Intern positions available within Wellness Services for the Summer 2010 term. This position will focus on developing and providing outreach services to UWF students related to prevention and health promotion. The specific areas of focus include alcohol misuse and abuse prevention, sexual assault prevention, and sexual health promotion.

#### Minimum requirements:

- Candidates must be enrolled at the University of West Florida seeking internship credits.
- Individuals should be highly-motivated with a positive attitude.
- Candidates should have basic computer skills with knowledge of Outlook and Microsoft Office programs (i.e. Word, Excel, Publisher).
- Must be willing to occasionally work flexible hours, including evenings and weekends as position requires.
- Organizational skills and excellent interpersonal, verbal, and written communication is needed.
- Candidates should also have a desire to learn about alcohol misuse and abuse prevention, sexual assault prevention, and sexual health promotion or specialize in one of these areas.
