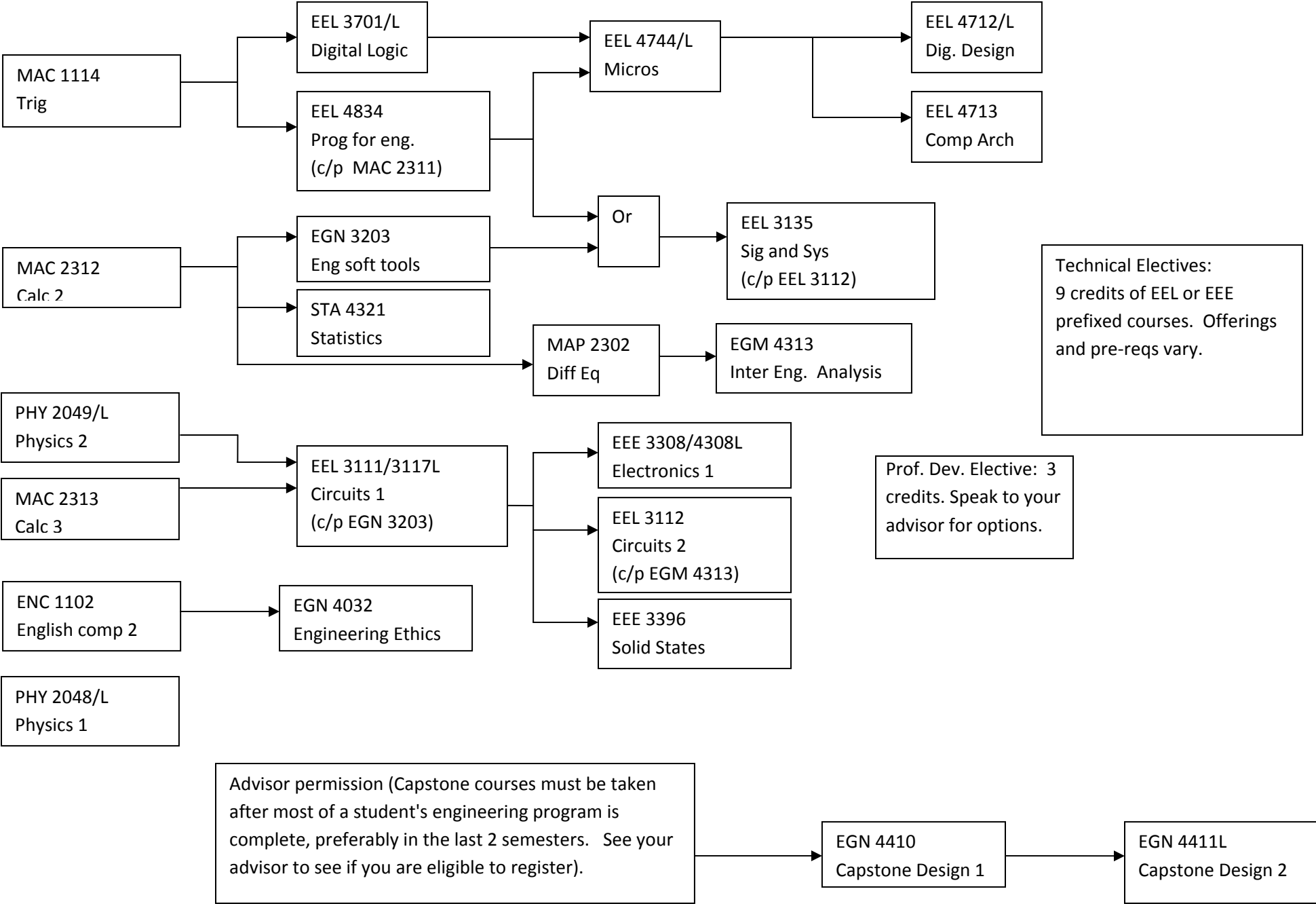
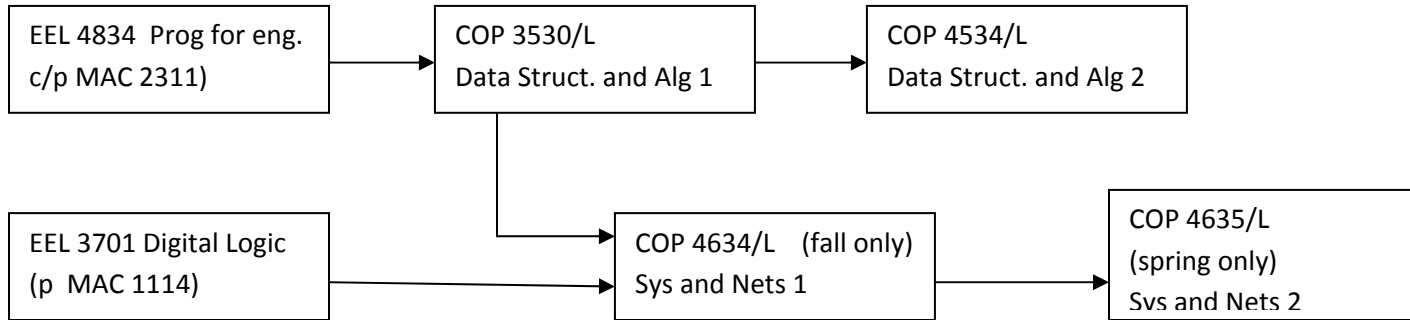


BSCE Flowchart of required engineering courses
