

“C” rule

Admission to the program:

All Electrical and Computer Engineering students must achieve a minimum grade of a C (note: C- is not considered a C) in each of the following courses to be admitted into their major:

MAC 2311
MAC 2312
MAC 2313
MAP 2302
PHY 2048
PHY 2049
CHM x045

In addition, the students must have a minimum of a C+ (2.3/4.0) average in these courses for admission.

Engineering Courses:

Students must also receive a minimum grade of “C” (again, C- is not acceptable) in the following courses and their corresponding labs that are required for the electrical and computer engineering degrees:

EEL 3112
EEL 3135
EEE 3308 and EEE 4308L
EEE 3396
EEL 3472 (EE only)
EEL 3701 and EEL 3701L

EEL 4834 (or its equivalent)
STA 4321 (cy 2007)
ENC 3240 (only students who take it as their professional development elective)

EGN 4410
EGN 4411L
Any required courses with COP, CEN, or CIS prefix (CE only)
Any other course with an EEL/EGN prefix that is a prereq for any electives that you may take.
