

## **Prerequisite and Co-requisite (including labs) Policy:**

The ECE department has worked diligently to create a sequence of courses that properly prepares students for courses that come later in the program. We want to make sure that you succeed and get as much out of each course as possible; therefore, we must enforce our prerequisites.

A student who completes a course without first completing its prerequisites (including meeting any minimum grade requirement in that prerequisite) will not be allowed to continue to the next course in a sequence until the prerequisites (and any co-requisites) are successfully completed. In addition, the student will be required to re take the class if he/she receive a grade of less than a C in the course.

A student who chooses to drop a course must also drop all classes for which the course is listed as a co-requisite (eg, if a student drops EEL 3111, he or she must also drop EEL 3117L).

Watch the coreq list carefully to determine which courses must be dropped. For example, EGM 4313 is listed as a coreq to EEL 3112, but EEL 3112 is not a coreq to EGM 4313. In other words, EGM 4313 can be taken prior to or at the same time as EEL 3112. Therefore, if you drop EGM 4313, you must also drop EEL 3112. But if you drop EEL3112, you do not need to drop EGM 4313. When in doubt, check with your advisor.

Note that if you pass a course but fail its coreq, you need only repeat the coreq (eg, if you pass EEL 3117L but not EEL 3111, you do not need to repeat EEL 3117L).
