Funds contributed from the Center for Lifelong Learning will provide \$1000 semester scholarships for students who are involved in any of the following UWF Emerald Coast student organizations:

- Criminal Justice Student Organization
- Extended Campus Activity Board
- Institute of Electrical & Electronics Engineers
- Student Government Association
- Teacher Education Club
- UWF Emerald Coast Student Ambassadors
- Alpha Sigma Lambda Honor Society

Another semester scholarship of \$500 will be provided for UWF Emerald Coast students who are not able to be involved with student organizations, but are majoring in programs offered at UWF Emerald Coast (listed above). Scholarships will be renewable for an additional semester as long as the student remains eligible according to established criteria.

Criteria for student eligibility includes the following:

- Current student in good standing in a UWF Emerald Coast academic program – for \$1000 and \$500 semester scholarships (Criminal Justice, General Business, Accounting, Management, Hospitality, Electrical Engineering, Computer Engineering, Elementary Education, Educational Leadership-Med/EdS, Business Administration-MBA, History-MA, Curriculum & Instruction EdS/EdD)

- Currently active in a UWF Emerald Coast student organization – for \$1000 semester scholarship (Criminal Justice Student Organization, Extended Campus Activity Board, Institute of Electrical & Electronics Engineers, Student Government Association, Teacher Education Club, UWF Emerald Coast Student Ambassadors, Alpha Sigma Lambda Honor Society)
- Currently designated as a UWF Emerald Coast student in CICS/Argus
- Has a minimum 3.2 GPA
- Demonstrates financial need
- Submits a one paragraph statement describing how the degree being pursued will help reach life and/or career goals and how the scholarship will assist with that endeavor
- Submits at least one letter of recommendation from a UWF Emerald Coast faculty member

Interested students should submit an application (attached), written statement, and letter(s) of recommendation to the Office of the Dean, UWF Emerald Coast. A selection committee made up of a Center for Lifelong Learning member, a UWF Emerald Coast faculty member, UWF Financial Aid representative, and a UWF Emerald Coast staff member will review all applications and make recommendations to the Dean. The UWF Emerald Coast Dean will notify students who have been selected for scholarships.
