Cost

The program fee is \$ 1,493, and includes:

- Accommodations with families
- Three meals per day
- Walking tour of the city
- Academic and administrative support
- Transfer from and to Barajas Airport in Madrid to Salamanca
- Full-day excursion by bus
- Socio-Cultural and Educational activities
- Pre-departure orientation session

The program fee does not include: round-trip international airfare, local transportation, UWF tuition (3 undergraduate-credit-hours), mandatory international health insurance fee, personal expenses for additional traveling, extra-curricular activities, and spending money.
