- For the session, bring a typed copy of your paper and a copy of your instructor's assignment

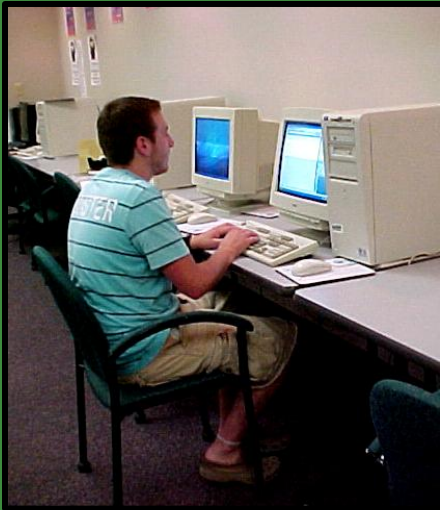


Thesis and Dissertation Readings

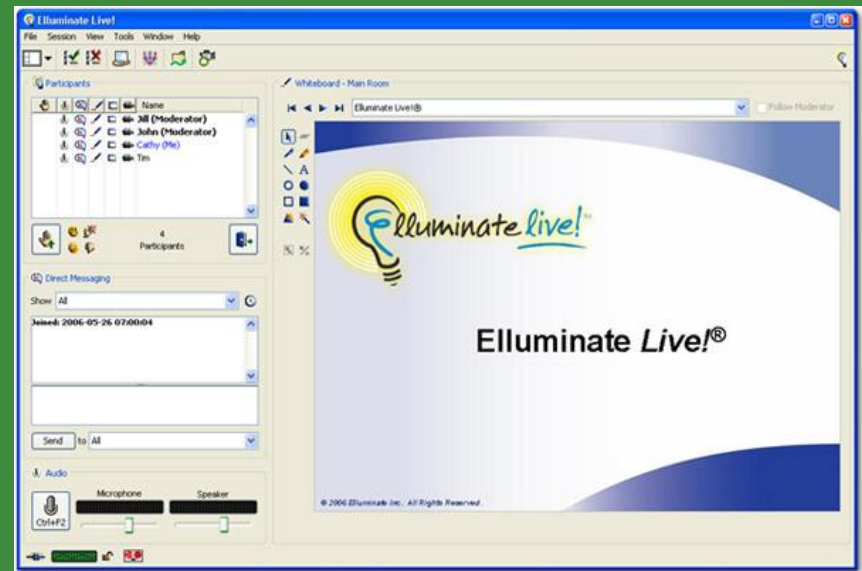
- 1 to 2 hour appointments available for thesis and dissertation documents and chapters

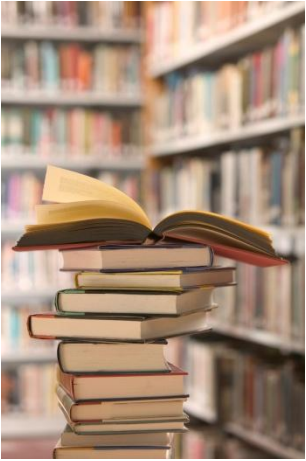
