HPV Testing Consent Form

HPV (Human Papilloma Virus) is a common virus that affects both females and males. Most HPV types are harmless and go away on their own. About 30 types of HPV are known as genital HPV since they affect the genital area. Some types are high risk and cause cervical cancer or abnormal cells in the lining of the cervix that sometimes turn into cancer. Others are low risk and can cause genital warts and changes in the cervix that are benign (abnormal but not cancerous.)

If your PAP results come back and are abnormal, it will be sent for high risk HPV testing. There is an additional \$50.00 charge for this test.
