Wireless Setup Instructions

Windows 7

1. From the **Start** menu open the **Control Panel**, click **Network and Internet**, click **Network and Sharing Center**, and click **Set up a connection or network**.
2. Click **Manually connect to a wireless network**.
3. Enter the following information:
 - Network name: **uwf-argo-air**
 - Security type: **WPA2-Enterprise**
 - Encryption type: **AES**
 - Make sure **Start this connection automatically** is checked.
4. Click **Next**, and then **Change connection settings**.
5. Make sure **Connect automatically when this network is in range** is checked.
6. Click the **Security** tab. Then, under *Choose a network authentication method*, select **Microsoft: Protected EAP (PEAP)**.
7. Checkmark **Remember my credentials for this connection each time I'm logged on**.
8. Click **Settings**.
9. Verify the following settings:
 - *Validate server certificate* is **NOT** checked
 - *Authentication Method*: **Secured password (EAP-MSCHAP v2)**
 - *Enable Fast Reconnect* is **NOT** checked
10. Click **Configure**.
11. **REMOVE** the checkmark from **Automatically use my Windows logon name and password (and domain if any)**.
12. Click **OK** in each of the open windows.
13. *Connecting for the First Time*: When in the range of the wireless network, Windows will attempt to connect. A balloon pop-up will appear in the taskbar. **Click the balloon**.
14. Enter the guest username and password, then click **OK**.

Windows XP

1. From the **Start** menu, select **Settings** then **Control Panel**, double click **Network Options**, then right click on **Wireless** and select **Properties**. (NOTE: If using *Category view*, select **Network and Internet Connections**, then **Network Connections**.)
2. On the **General** tab verify that **Show icon in notification area when connected** is checked.
3. Select the **Wireless Networks** tab.
 - Verify that **Use Windows to configure my wireless network settings** is checked.
 - In the Preferred networks section, click **Add...**
4. On the **Association** tab, enter the following:
 - Network name (SSID): **uwf-argo-air**
 - Network Authentication: **WPA2**
 - Data Encryption: **AES**
5. Select the **Authentication** tab, then,
 - Verify that **Enable IEEE 802.1x auth. for this network** is checked.
 - Change the *EAP type* to **Protected EAP (PEAP)**.
 - **REMOVE** the checkmark from **Authenticate as computer when computer information is available**
 - Click **Properties**.
6. Verify the following:
 - Verify that *Validate server certificate* is **NOT** checked.
 - Verify that *Authentication Method* is set to **Secured password (EAP-MSCHAP v2)**
 - Verify that *Enable Fast Reconnect* is **NOT** checked.
 - Click **Configure...**
7. Remove the checkmark from **Automatically use my Windows logon name and password (and domain if any)**, then click **OK** in each of the open windows back to the *Network Connections* window.
8. When in the range of the wireless network, Windows will attempt to connect. A balloon pop-up will appear in the taskbar. **Click the balloon**.
9. Enter the guest username and password, and then click **OK**.
10. Once successfully logged in, the **Wireless** network in the **Network Connections** window should say **Authentication succeeded**.

Mac OS X

10.6 Snow Leopard

1. Open **System Preferences**, then click the **Network** icon.
2. Select **Airport**. Then, click **Advanced...**
3. Click the **+** button.
4. Beside *Network Name*, type **uwf-argo-air**. In the *Security* drop-down box, select **WPA2-Enterprise**.
5. Enter the guest username and password. Make sure that *802.1X* is set to **Automatic**. Click **Add**.
6. **uwf-argo-air** should appear in your list of preferred networks. Click **OK**.
7. Click **Always Allow**.
8. Click **Show Certificate**.
9. Check the box at the top labeled **Always trust...** Click **Continue**. You may be asked to enter your Mac password. Note: *The certificate may be named "rauth2.argo.uwf.edu."*
10. If your airport connection is off, turn it on now. If you are in the ArgoAir coverage area, it should connect automatically.

10.7 Lion

1. Open **System Preferences**, then click the **Network** icon.
2. Select **Wi-Fi**. Then, click **Advanced...**
3. Click the **+** button.
4. Beside *Network Name*, type **uwf-argo-air**. In the *Security* drop-down box, select **WPA/WPA2-Enterprise**.
5. Enter the guest username and password. Click **OK**.
6. **uwf-argo-air** should appear in your list of preferred networks. Click **OK**.
7. Click **Apply**. The *Network Name* box should change to *uwf-argo-air*.
8. Click **Show Certificate**.
9. Check the box labeled **Always trust "radius.uwf.edu"**. Click **Continue**.
10. If your Wi-Fi connection is off, turn it on now. If you are in the ArgoAir coverage area, it should connect automatically.
