

There are two options for international wire transfers. If the banking institution that you use transfers your payment to a bank in New York, you would want to use option number one because it is a faster and economical way. If your bank does not have a bank they use to process wire transfers you will need to use option 2.

Option 1

1. Your bank will transfer the money to the bank they use which is located in New York. Your bank will need to include your name and the reason you are wiring the money (Summer Tuition).
2. The New York banking institution will transfer the money to the Columbus Bank & Trust Company, Columbus, GA
 - ABA Routing Number: 061100606
 - Beneficiary Bank: Coastal Bank and Trust #560
 - Beneficiary: University of West Florida
 - Beneficiary Account Number: 7943
 - Reference Information: Student Name & Reference Number –
3. Columbus Bank and Trust will wire the money to the Coastal Bank and Trust

Option 2

If your bank is not associated with a bank in New York, you will need to give the following instructions to your bank:
