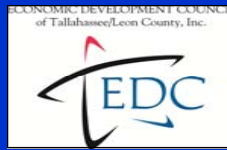

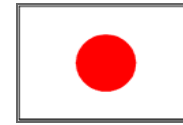
What is the Southeast U.S./Japan Association?
