

EVOLUTION VERSUS CREATIONISM

Creationists offer *certainty* without empirical evidence. They rely largely on *authority*

Evolutionists, being scientists, instead offer *confirming empirical evidence* without certainty (or proof) for their theories regarding the principles and mechanisms of operation.

In *science*, it is recognized that nothing is ever *proven beyond a doubt*--rather hypotheses and theories can only be *substantiated, or confirmed*, by supporting evidence, and by escaping being disproved. It is also understood that through additional research more complete and accurate explanations for phenomena might be found.

It should be noted that although what *Darwin* proposed was a *theory* of evolution by natural selection, the *phenomenon* of evolution itself, by whatever mechanism(s), is now recognized by science as an *incontestable fact*. This is based on logic as well as overwhelming empirical evidence, which is available to anyone who will simply look with an open mind.
