Applications are invited for a tenure track position at the Assistant or Associate Professor level available August, 2009, as noted below and dependent upon funding. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience.

One position in Management – Primary teaching duties will be undergraduate and graduate courses in Strategic Management. Candidates should have a secondary teaching emphasis in other sub-disciplines of Management such as General Management, Organization Behavior, Ethics, Entrepreneurship, or Human Resources Management.

Preferred candidates will have a Ph.D. in teaching field or in a closely related field from an Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB) accredited school at the time of appointment. ABDs will be considered; but must provide strong evidence that the doctoral degree will be completed prior to December, 2009. Candidates must demonstrate the potential to pursue a balanced commitment to excellent teaching, productive research, and active professional and community service. A strong record of scholarly publication and teaching excellence is required for appointment at the rank of Associate Professor. Applications will also be considered from those interested in a visiting appointment.

Successful candidates will also be required to perform academic and career counseling, to serve on departmental, college and university committees, participate in assessment activities, and to undertake scholarly activities. A normal teaching load is three courses per semester. This position may require teaching at other campuses of the university. Opportunities for summer support for teaching or research are normally available. Opportunities also exist for faculty to teach abroad at UWF partner schools.

The College of Business is AACSB accredited with over 1800 students enrolled in six undergraduate majors and two masters programs. The main campus of The University of West Florida is located in Pensacola, the crown jewel of Florida's beautiful Emerald Coast, known worldwide for its pristine white-sand beaches. The area is famous for its pleasant climate and location on the Gulf of Mexico, and enjoys a comparatively low cost of living. The campus is situated on a 1,600 acre nature preserve where 10,000 students enjoy the benefits of small classes and personal attention from their professors. UWF is part of the Florida Board of Education's Division of Colleges and Universities.
