Mission Statement

The Minor in Military Science assists ROTC students in meeting the criteria for a commission as an Officer in the United States Army, Army Reserve, or Army National Guard. The courses emphasize leadership and management training while a laboratory provides experience in a range of leadership positions. Practical experience is gained at a summer camp normally attended between the junior and senior years. The minor is only open to ROTC students.

Student Learning Outcomes

1. Knowledge of training management, Army Doctrine, and cultural awareness.
2. Thrive in operationally ambiguous environments through critical thinking, problem solving, and team building.
3. Skilled oral and written communicator with advanced interpersonal skills.
4. Demonstrate leadership values and a professional identity, and display characteristics of a lifelong learner.

Assessment Methodology

All four domains are taught and discussed in classroom environment, but they are assessed during lab training, field training exercises, and Cadet Summer Training.
