

## Marion Viccars Award

The Marion Viccars Award was established by former UWF President James Robinson, recognizing superior service of university employees. Marion Viccars began working at the new University of West Florida's John C. Pace Library in 1967. She was an enthusiastic participant in the academic life of the university, an energetic promoter of West Florida's historical preservation activities and a warm and cordial counselor to students and scholars everywhere.

### Highlights:

- **Employees at the Director level and above, and Faculty Administrators (including Dean, Associate and Assistant Deans, Chairperson, and those retiring within the academic year) are eligible to apply or be nominated for the award.**
- **Nominated employees must have worked at UWF for three (3) years as of March 1, 2012.**
- **The award recipient receives a \$2000 (gross) cash award and a certificate of appreciation.**
- **The award recipient will be selected on the basis of outstanding job performance as well as service to the university and the community.**
- **The award will be presented at the annual university awards ceremony in April 19, 2012.**
