

William M. Healey Leadership Award

Criteria

1. Nominee must be a current student at UWF, employed by, serving as an intern for, or be an outstanding participant in any program managed by Recreation and Sports Services. An individual's relationship to Recreation and Sports Services may include but is not limited to their role as: fitness center monitor/supervisor; group fitness instructor/supervisor; personal trainer; outdoor adventure trip leader; climbing center instructor; special events facilitator; sailing attendant; aquatic center lifeguard/facility supervisor/instructor/registrar/cashier; administrative office staff; intramural sports supervisor/sport official/ sport manager/team captain/outstanding participant; sport club leader/officer; recreation sports intern; facility attendant/customer service rep/building manager/maintenance crew; or graduate assistant.
2. Overall GPA of 2.85 or greater.
3. Nominee must demonstrate leadership, sportsmanship, integrity, credibility and loyalty to Recreation and Sports Services while exhibiting commitment to the mission, vision and values of the department and The University of West Florida.
4. Nominee may be recommended by a professional staff member from Recreation and Sports Services, a UWF faculty or staff member, an alumni, co-worker, or peer.
5. Nominee must submit a nomination form, current resume, and two letters of nomination/ recommendation to the William M. Healey Award Selection Committee by the designated deadline. A winner and finalists will be selected in March. The awards will be announced in April at the annual Student Affairs Leadership Awards Banquet.
