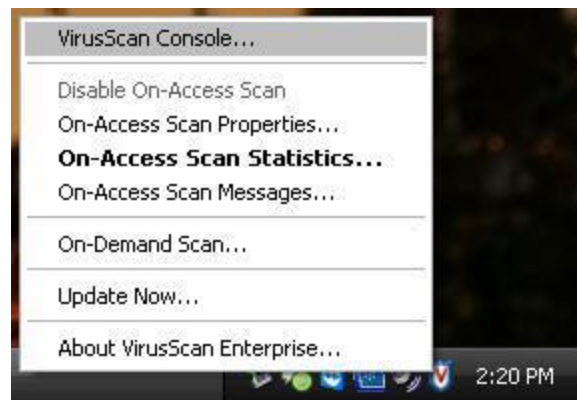


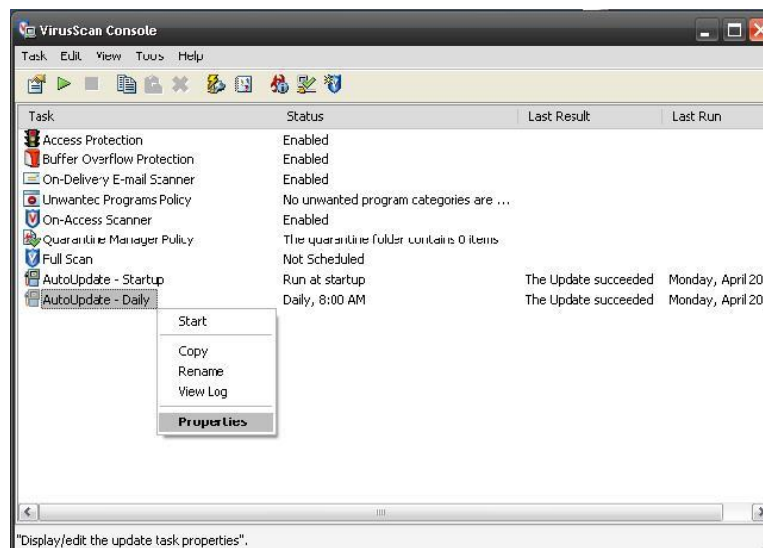


In order to detect and/or clean the latest viruses, you should schedule McAfee VirusScan to update its virus definitions daily. The following steps illustrate how to schedule the pre-defined AutoUpdate task. This task requires an active internet connection.

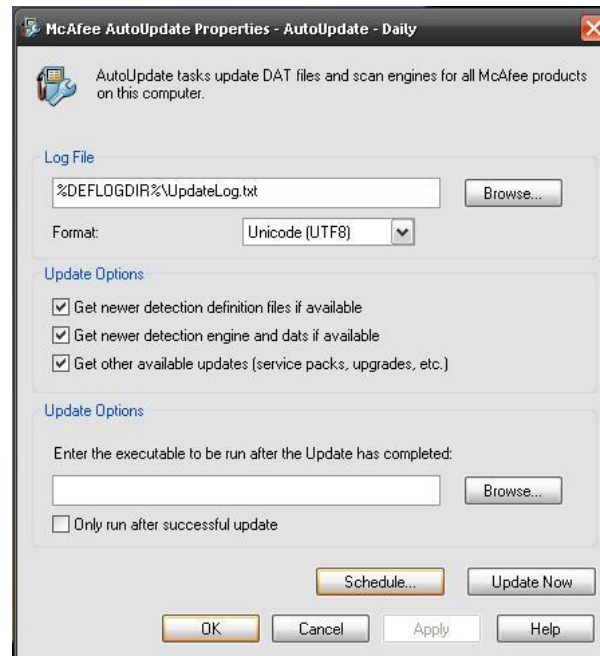
1. Locate the McAfee shield in the taskbar and right-click the icon. When the menu appears, click **VirusScan Console**.



2. When the VirusScan Console appears, right click on **AutoUpdate - Daily** and click **Properties**.



3. When the **AutoUpdate Properties** window opens, click the **Schedule** option.



4. Another window labeled **Schedule Settings** should open. In this window, click the **Schedule** tab. Here is where you can choose a time and frequency for the McAfee AutoUpdate to occur. Uncheck **Enable Randomization** and choose a time when you know your computer will be turned on and connected to the Internet and click **OK**.
