University of West Florida offers the MAT in computer-based format only. Scheduling information follows:

1. You may schedule the MAT at the following times beginning **on the hour or half-hour**:
Monday: 9:30 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. (**exams must be complete by 4:30 p.m.**)
Tuesday: 12:30 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. (**exams must be complete by 7:30 p.m.**)
Wednesday: 9:30 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. (**exams must be complete by 4:30 p.m.**)
Thursday: 12:30 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. (**exams must be complete by 7:30 p.m.**)
Friday: 9:30 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. (**exams must be complete by 4:30 p.m.**)
2. You must pay the fee prior to scheduling an appointment. You can mail in the payment with this registration form to the cashier's office or pay in person. The cashier's office will not accept payments by phone or online. If you are unable to do this at least one day in advance, you should call the testing office to find out more information about walk-ins.
3. **The \$75.00 MAT fee is NON-REFUNDABLE.** If you wish to reschedule, there is a \$20.00 rescheduling fee.
4. If you have taken the MAT anywhere in the last 12 months, you must present a retest admission ticket to schedule your test.
5. You must report to the testing center 15 minutes prior to your scheduled test time. If you report late you may be asked to reschedule and pay the \$20.00 rescheduling fee.
6. You must present valid government issued Identification with photo and signature to be admitted to your test. Student ID or expired identification is not acceptable.

ABOUT THE TEST:

- The test is 60 minutes in length and contains 120 questions. The examinee will have basic information to enter in the computer that should take approximately 15 minutes. The total appointment length is 90 minutes.
- Each test item appears on a separate screen giving the examinee the option of answering the item, skipping it and going on to the next item, or returning to the previous items.
- At the end of the test, if there is time left, examinees may review all of the items or return to those items they have skipped.
- An "UNOFFICIAL" score report will be printed for you at the conclusion of the test. The "OFFICIAL" score report will be mailed within 2 weeks to you and the institutions you have selected.

NOTE: Arrangements for special accommodations must be made 3 weeks in advance.
