

**University of West Florida Regulation**

**UWF/REG-3.002 Admission to Graduate Programs and Post-Baccalaureate Professional Students.**

- (1) Admission requirements for graduate programs at The University of West Florida (“UWF”) are governed by the Florida Board of Governors’ Regulation 6.003 and shall be consistent with the mission of the University.
- (2) Admission requirements for graduate programs are determined by the departments that administer the programs and shall be consistent with the university-wide policy pertaining to admission of graduate and post-baccalaureate professional students. The university-wide graduate admissions policy and requirements shall be approved by the Provost upon recommendation by the University’s Graduate Council, Academic Council, and Faculty Senate. The university-wide graduate and post-baccalaureate student graduate admission requirements shall be specified in the University catalog.
- (3) Prospective students who have been denied admission to a graduate program at UWF may appeal in writing, following procedures approved by the Provost and specified in the University catalog.
- (4) UWF shall periodically review this regulation and policies pertaining to the admission of graduate and post-baccalaureate professional students to minimize unnecessary impediments to access, while maintaining academic quality and integrity.
